

RFP 26-022

Social Services for The Homeless Case Management, Shelter, and Transportation Grants Administered by The County Department of Human Services

A review committee was convened for the purpose of evaluating requests for proposals submitted to the Purchasing Department in response to RFP 26-022 for the Passaic Department of Human Services. The committee consisted of Michelle Chan, Jasmine Doughty, and Claireth Bolano with consultation provided by Yonette Fredericks and Francine Vince.

The review committee convened on June 12, 2026. Three project clusters were listed in RFP 26-022. Proposals were evaluated utilizing the following criteria:

Management- 30 points, Technical -50 points and Cost -20 points

Below are the Vendors that submitted proposals and a composite point total of the evaluation.

Program #1 Rides Program

- A. Proposal submitted by: Meadowlands Transportation Brokerage Corp d/b/a EZ Ride, 144 Park Place East, Wood-Ridge, NJ 07075

Committee feedback and analysis: This proposal addresses all of the components requested in the RFP. The proposed program will meet the stated need.

Total Composite Score: 91

Program # 1 committee recommendations:

- \$ 30,000.00 to be awarded to Meadowlands Transportation Brokerage Corp d/b/a EZ Ride for Rides Program.

Program #2 Family Shelter:

- A. Proposal submitted by: Heart of Hannah Women's Center Inc., 421 Lakeview Ave, Clifton, NJ 07011

Committee feedback and analysis: The vendor did not submit proof of an existing shelter license. The number of units in the proposal did not equal the total cost in the budget. The proposal is for only 2 families to be served during a 12 month period which is not in alignment with SSH requirements.

Total Composite Score: 72

- B. Proposal submitted by: Eva's Village Inc d/b/a Eva's Kitchen, 393 Main Street Paterson, NJ 07501

Committee feedback and analysis: The vendor applied to provide an individual shelter, not a family shelter and is not eligible under this RFP.

Total Composite Score: N/A

C. Proposal submitted by: St. Peter's Haven Corporation, 380 Clifton Ave, Clifton, NJ 07011

Committee feedback and analysis: The proposal set clear eligibility requirements that are in alignment with SSH requirements. Program outcomes could be better developed. The application could contain more detail about the services and methodologies. Overall this is a quality proposal.

Proposal submitted by: Real House Inc., 95 Grove Street, Montclair, NJ 07042

Committee feedback and analysis: The vendor applied to provide an individual shelter, not a family shelter and is not eligible under this RFP.
