On behalf of the Greenwood Lake Commission, I am writing to you to thank you for your generous contribution of \$60,000. The Commission's sole purpose, having been created by the legislators of New York and New Jersey, is to protect the natural resources of Greenwood Lake for recreational and economic gain. As you are aware, the Commission was never given a means on obtaining revenue, and this investment will aid us in the pursuit of our goals.

Passaic County has been generous in the past, and we greatly appreciate all your support. I am happy to report that the Commission has held several successful projects, thanks to your support. We have completed applications of herbicides to curb invasive species of aquatic plants. We have a partnership with local universities to conduct water quality testing, which moving forward will include specific HABs testing, and we are on track to start cleaning up Belchers Creek which is the number one hot spot of our lake pollution.

Our success is in no small part due to your continued support. Thank you again for your effort to preserve and protect Greenwood Lake.
