**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS TO VARIOUS PROVIDERS OF SERVICES UNDER THE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR ADDICTION SERVICES, PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1, ET SEQ.**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Passaic (“County”) is a body politic and corporate pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:18-1 and vested with all rights contained therein; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:20-1, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Passaic (“Board”) is vested with managing the property, finances, and affairs of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Human Services (“Department”) is an umbrella social service agency concerned with planning and funding services for disadvantaged and homeless citizens, such as through the County Comprehensive Plan for Addiction Services Grant, which is administered by the Department; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1(b)(2) specifically authorizes the County to utilize competitive contracting to procure services related to the operation, management or administration of social service programs, including the programs described in this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.3, the Board approved Resolution R-2018-1075, dated December 27, 2018, authorizing the Department to initiate the RFP process to procure services related to addiction services; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 4, 2025, the Purchasing Agent issued RFP-26-008, County Comprehensive Plan for Addiction Services Grant Administered by the County Department of Human Services (“RFP-26-008”), and unsealed responses to RFP-26-008 on January 6, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the law, a review committee was convened to review the responses to RFP-26-008, and in a memorandum dated January 20, 2026, attached hereto and made part of this Resolution, the review committee recommended the following contract awards under RFP-26-008, each for a one-year term from January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026, with the County retaining four (4) one-year options to renew, contingent on availability of funds and satisfactory performance:

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, these contracts are being awarded under a fair and open procurement process, which requires that a contract be: publicly advertised in sufficient time to give notice in advance of the contract; awarded under a process that provides for public solicitation of proposals or qualifications; awarded and disclosed under criteria established in writing by the public entity prior to the solicitation of proposals or qualifications; and publicly opened and announced when awarded; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:32-60-1, et seq., the contracted providers all executed the Non-Involvement in Prohibited Activities in Russia or Belarus Certification, attached hereto and made part of this Resolution, certifying that they are not involved in prohibited activities in Russia and Belarus, and the County confirmed that said providers are not identified on the Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons list created by the Office of Foreign Assets Control; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available in Account Nos. G-01-41-737-026-213 (\$279,663.00) and 6-01-27-162-004-213 (\$60,337.00), or any other account that may be deemed appropriate by the Chief Financial Officer or his designee, and the availability of funds has been contingently certified by the Chief Financial Officer subject to sufficient funds being appropriated by the Board in the 2026

and/or subsequent County budget(s), which is attached hereto and made part of this Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, this matter was discussed at the February 18, 2026, Health and Human Service Committee meeting, and is being recommended to the Board for approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1, et seq., the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Passaic authorizes the following contract awards under RFP-26-008, each for a one-year term from January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026, with the County retaining four (4) one-year options to renew, contingent on availability of funds and satisfactory performance, all in accordance with RFP-26-008 and the providers' responses thereto:
